### **Review your signage**

**Are your services /events times clear? Are the entrances visible and accessible? Do posters/displays speak of inclusion and love?**

**Remember to remove any information that is incorrect or out of date**

### **Welcome and Follow ups**

**If you can, have friendly greeters outside to help people as they arrive, and remember to give clear instructions throughout the service. If possible, ask for contact details so that you can invite them to future events.**
